MULCAHY coat of arms¹

Mulcahy (Ó Maolchathaigh) Maolchathaigh

This notable Munster surname is an Anglicized form of the Old Gaelic "O'Maolchathaigh", descendant of Maolchathaigh, an ancient male given name composed of the elements "maol", from the pagan Irish "mal", chief, and related to the Welsh "mail", hero, with "cathaigh", the genitive of "cathach", warlike. Traditionally, Irish family names are taken from the heads of tribes, revered elders, or some illustrious warrior, and are usually prefixed by "Mac", denoting "son of", or "O", grandson, male descendant of. The "O'Maolchathaigh" sept is said to have originated in south Tipperary, and 17th Century records show that the name was numerous in that county, as well as in the neighbouring counties of Waterford, Limerick and Cork.

COUNTY LIMERICK, IRELAND

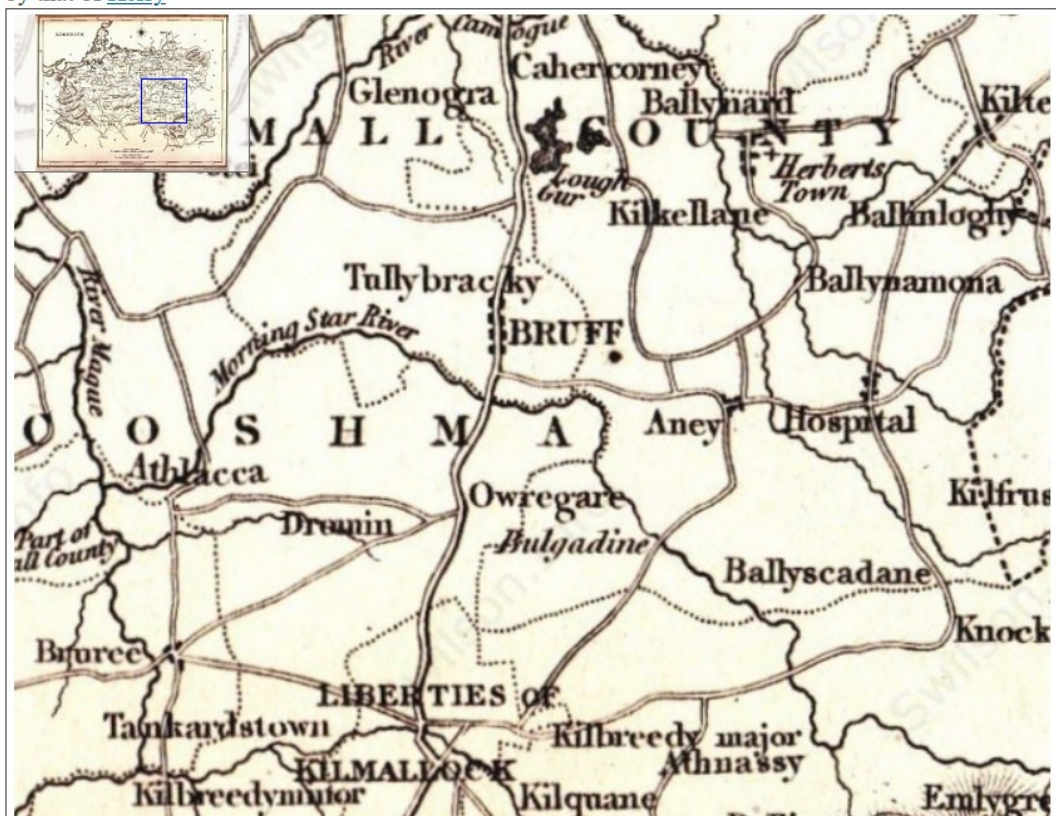
Michael's death church record says born at "Broff Limerick, son of Patrick Mulcahey and of Ellen Michan, husband of Margaret Cantilon deceased in this parish, the twelfth instant, aged eighty eight years." This corresponds to other records found. Marriage and baptismal documents are found in the parish of Bruff, Limerick, which is confirmed also in a death certificate for Michael Mulcahy.

The 1901 census for Michael says his birth date is 22 Sep 1816 in Ireland. His baptismal record is actually 6 Sep 1816 in Bruff and the parentage matches his death record of Patrick Mulcahy and Ellen Meehan. Tracing the records in Bruff back, I found the marriage records for Patrick Mulcahy and Ellen Bridget Meehan, and his address is given as Ballyvolane, in County Limerick.

Where in County Limerick?

Showing the town of Bruff (at map center) and the areas just below it, which would be the location of Ballyvolane in County Limerick. This is where the Patrick Mulcahy family lived and went to church in the town of Bruff, as shown here on this Lewis 1837 map:² Note also the location of the Morning Star River. Ballyvolane would be located in the large capital letter A of the word C O S H M A, just below BRUFF, just as the river jets out and bends to go southeast.

County LIMERICK, in the province of MUNSTER, bounded on the north by the estuary of the Shannon and the county of [Tipperary](#), on the east by the same county; on the south by that of [Cork](#), and on the west by that of [Kerry](#)

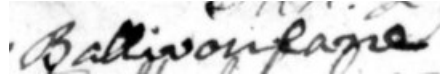

Ballyvolane

Ballyvolane, Baile an Mhulláin, Banogue, Co. Limerick, Ireland is just a few miles southeast of Bruff. It is not to be confused with the Ballyvolane in Co. Cork, Ireland. This one is located between Bruff and Banogue, and midway between Bruff and Knockainey. This is the address given on Patrick Mulcahy's marriage to Bridget Meehan in 1806 at the parish in Bruff. The address given is "Ballivoulane."

When I spoke with the kind persons at Limerick Genealogy, they suggested the following, confirming the townland I had found:

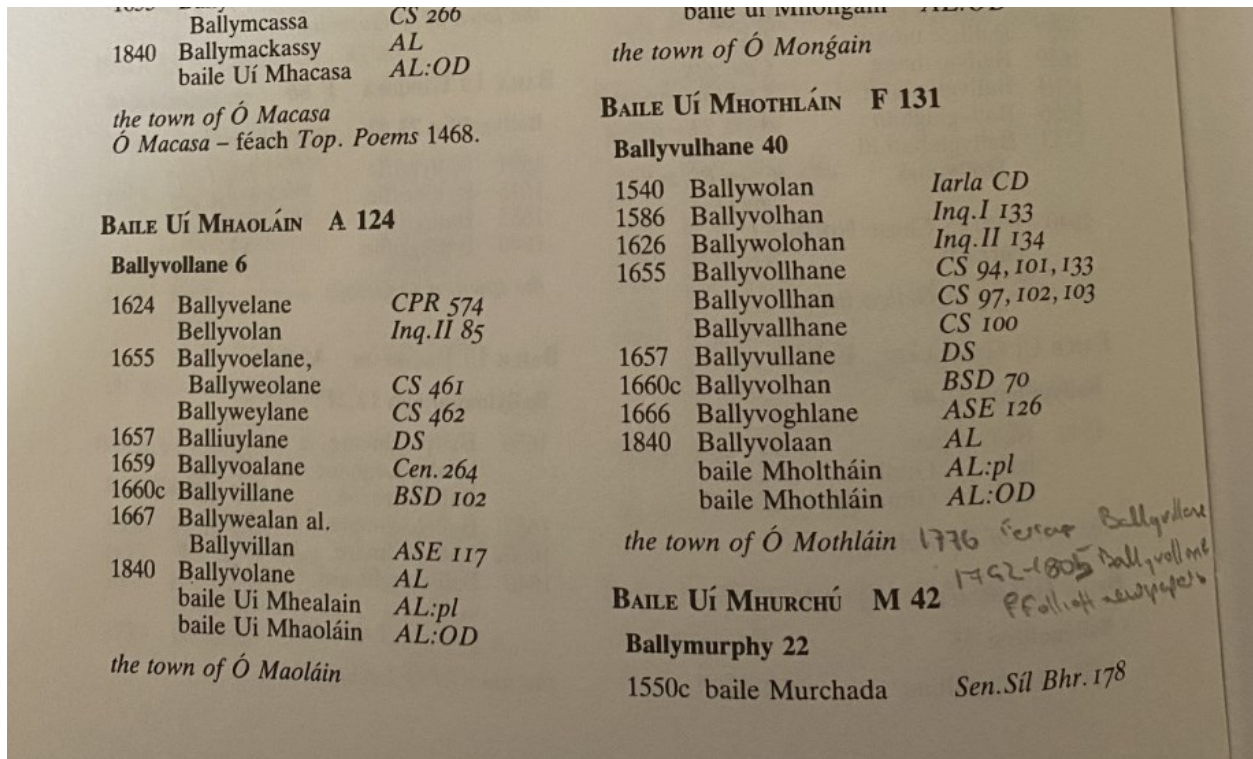
“I would suggest that Patrick’s address could refer to the townland of Ballyvulhane/Ballyvolane on the border of the parishes of Bruff, and Dromin and Athlacca, since the older children were all born in Bruff. I would agree that there could have been other unrecorded children, considering the gaps between those on record and the fact that the family moved parishes. Perhaps some could have been baptised in Dromin and Athlacca parish which has no records until 1817.

“In terms of other records for this period, in the first half of the nineteenth century, church records are really the main genealogical source. Ancillary sources for this time would include the Tithe Applotment Books and gravestone inscriptions but their relevance depends on the family’s circumstances. In this case, since Patrick appears to have worked as a labourer, he would not be listed in the Tithe Books which relate only to income from farm land (although I would still have a look). Typically only those of comfortable means could afford a gravestone inscription in the early to mid-nineteenth century but again it is worth a look.”³

They also appended the following image showing the two towns of Ballyvolane and Ballyvulhane and how their names progressed from the 1500s onward.

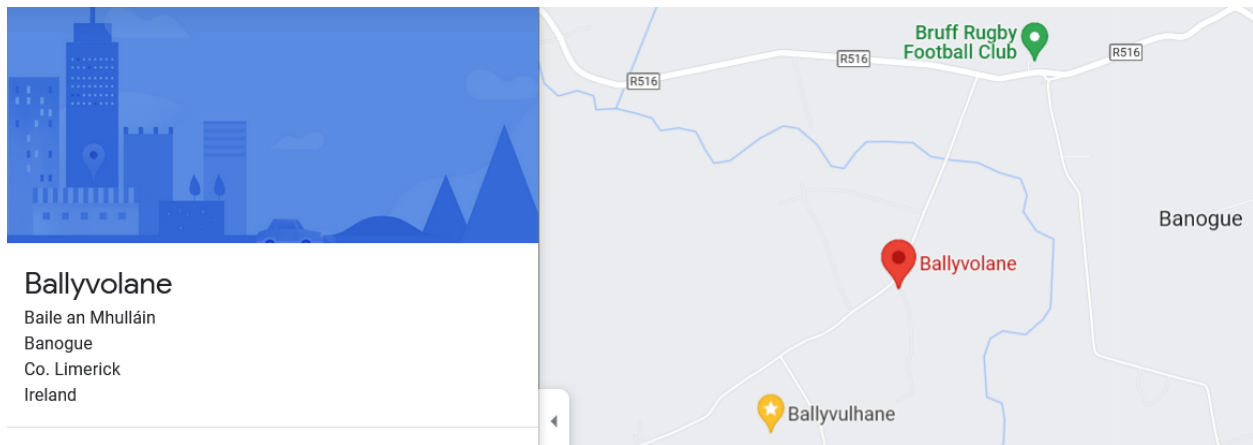
Figure 2: Insert from Irish book LUMINEACH (from Limerick Genealogy) showing townland names from early 1500s-present:

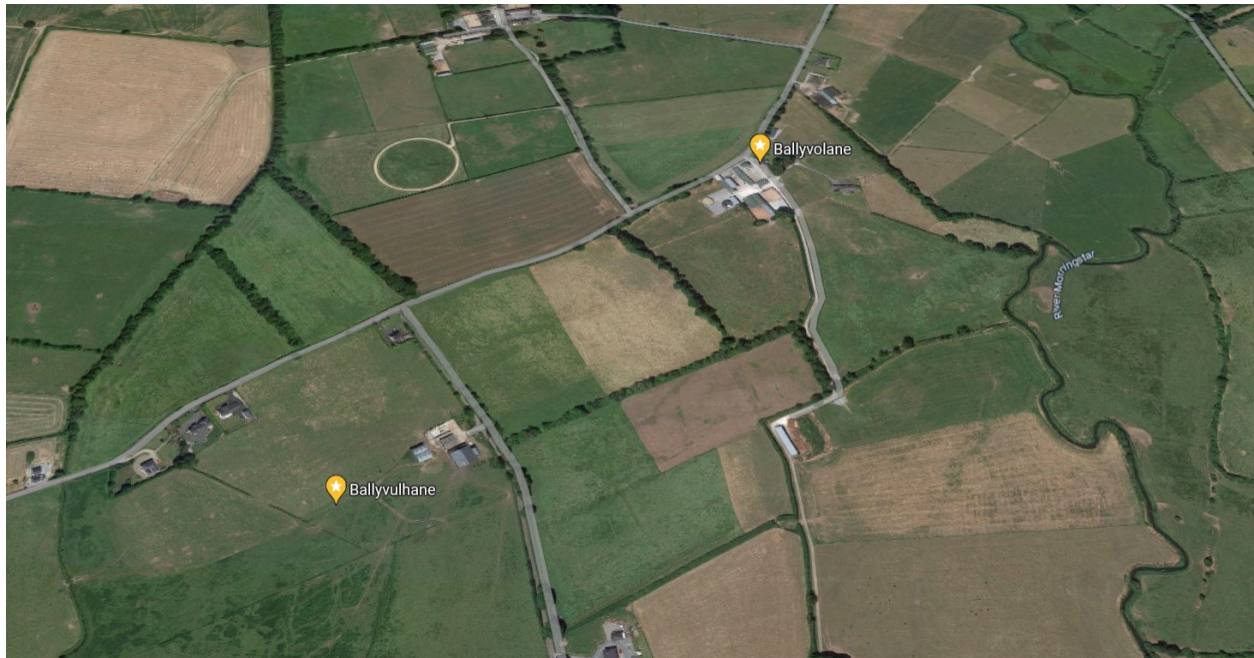


In 1840, the two townlands are nearly shared in terms of names – Ballyvolane and Ballyvolaan. Patrick would have been married in 1806 and likely born about 1786. Traveling would have been great effort, so it is most probable that Patrick's parentage also came from this townland or nearby.

Baile ui Mhealáin literally translates to “home of charms” in Irish.

The two towns are side by side, a distance of 750 meters. While the exact house cannot be pinpointed without visiting Ireland, this is the area the Mulcahy's came from in Limerick.





Ballyvolane / Ballyvulhane is adjacent to the Morningstar River. There is a bridge there called Ballyvulhane Bridge, which was originally built in 1819 and rebuilt in 1922:⁴

A bridge whose round arches make a pleasing impression at a crossing over the Morningstar River. The bridge was rebuilt (1922) to designs by Robert Davison (1872-1951), County Surveyor for the Eastern Division of County Limerick (appointed 1914), possibly following an attack during the Civil War (1922-3),

and a plaque is inscribed: "BALLYVOLANE [sic]/BRIDGE/REBUILT/1922/ROBERT DAVISON/Co SURVEYOR".



Figure 4: Map (zoomed in – scale at bottom) showing Ballyvolane next to Bruff:⁵

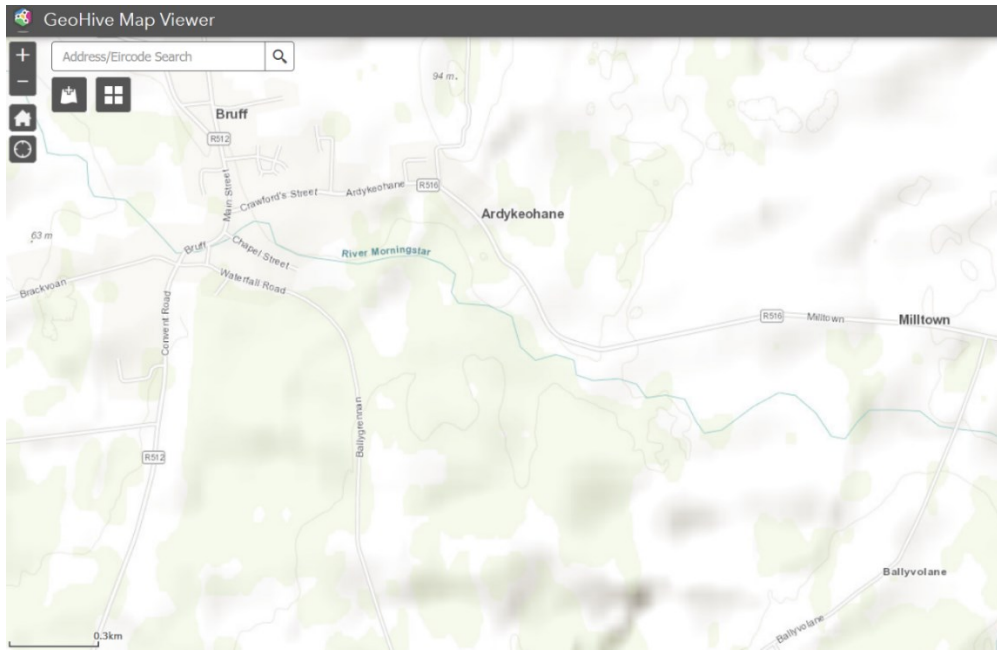
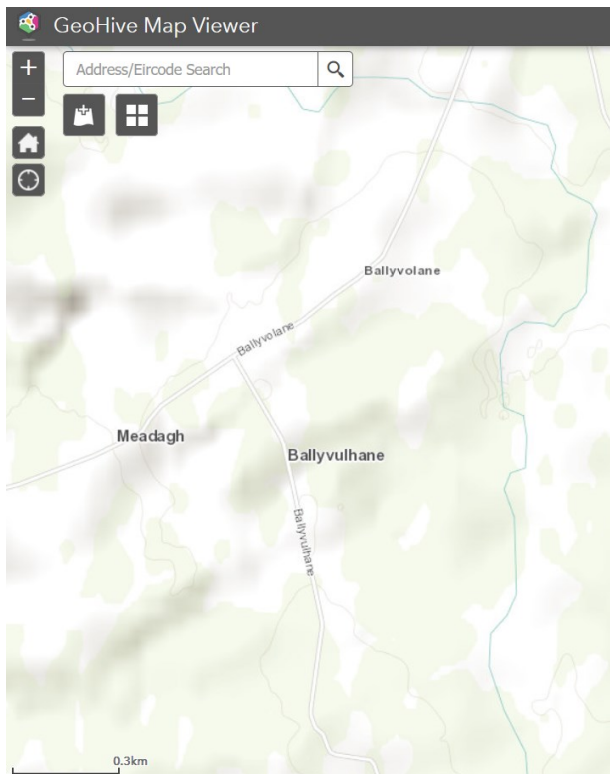


Figure 5: Map (zoomed in further) to show Ballyvolane and Ballyvulhane, nestled in the crook of the River Morningstar (blue line):

Bruff



Bruff is a town in east County Limerick, located on the old Limerick - Cork Road (R512), in the Ballyhoura region. The town lies on the Morning Star River, with two town bridges crossing the river.⁶ The peaceful rural town of Bruff is located in the heart of the Golden Vale of Munster in County Limerick. The town is full of fascinating historical buildings and features, and it is rich in local heritage and culture, contributing significantly to the story of Ireland.

Bruff is also famed for its contribution to the history of the United States of America, as Bruff is the ancestral home of one of America's most famous dynasties – the **Fitzgerald Kennedys**, linked with John F. Kennedy.⁷ Thomas Fitzgerald who emigrated from Bruff in 1852 was great grandfather to ***John Fitzgerald Kennedy, 35th president of the United States.***

After their marriage, several of the children were baptised in Bruff, Banogue, Co. Limerick, Ireland. The church of St. Peter & Paul's which is standing in Bruff was built in 1828 (after the baptisms date).⁸ However, there are still several Mulcahys buried in the church graveyard who are most likely relatives, though more recent.⁹ It is a small graveyard of only 55 memorials. It is still a symbol of proof of the Mulcahy family in the

area. At this time I am uncertain of the exact relationship of the following Mulcahy gravestone to your family, but felt it was worthwhile to include in the report.

Upon researching, the Richard Mulcahy family was a Farmer living in Garbally, about 5 kms from Ballyvalone / Ballyvulhane, where other Mulcahy residents lived. Richard Mulcahy appears on the 1901 and 1911 census in Bruff, County Limerick, Ireland.

Elton

Townland: Elton, Parish: Knockainy, Barony: Smallcounty, County: Limerick

Between 1816 and 1820, the Patrick Mulcahy family moved residences, about 9 kilometers to the southeast from Ballyvalone. By 1820 on son John's baptism, the Mulcahy family is living in Elton (Eiltiún Knocktoran), Kilmallock, Co. Limerick, Ireland. The parish of Knockainy & Patrickswell is adjacent to Bruff. In the following image, it shows Patt Mulcahy Lab [Labourer] Elton:

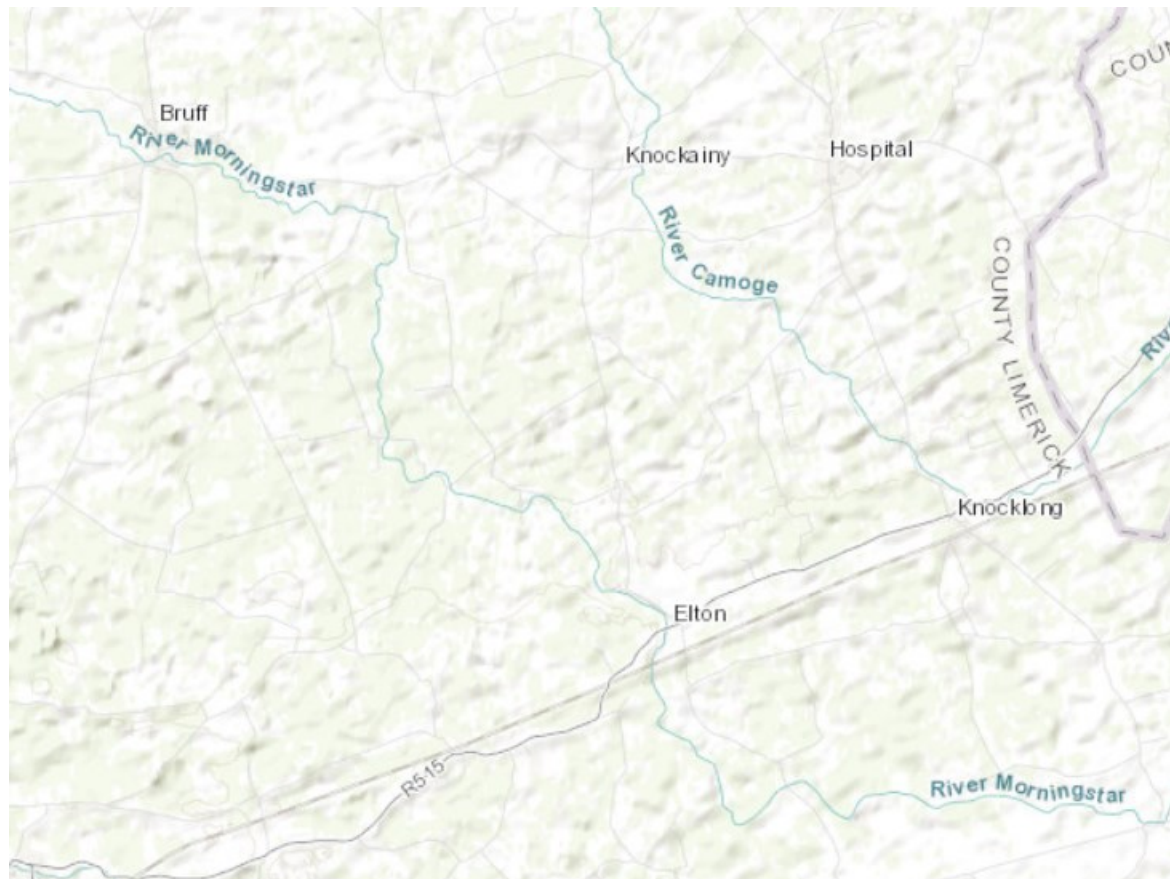
Figure 6: Image of 1820 baptism showing the word Elton:



On the same Lewis 1837 map as before, the town of Elton would fall below the letter y in the word Ballyscadane – center of map), as Elton is also found on the Morningstar River which forks just below where Elton is. Note, the town of BRUFF is center left.

Is Patrick alive in 1851 in Limerick?

We know he is in Elton in 1820. What happened to him after that? His son Michael emigrated to Canada by 1851 (first Quebec, then Ontario). **Did the other children emigrate overseas also? Did any of them stay in Ireland to be with the parents? Was Patrick still living at the time of the Tithe Applotments or the Griffith's Valuation?**

There are no Mulcahy's still in residing in the Townland of Elton on the Griffith's Valuation (1847-1864).¹¹ However, a search for "Patrick Mulcahy" in Limerick offered 38 search results, with two *probable* residences, if he is still living. This is a lot of persons named Patrick Mulcahy living in Limerick. It was a popular name.

Comparing the three known residences:

1806 – Townland: **Ballyvolane**, Parish: Bruff, **Union: Kilmallock**, Barony: Coshma, County: Limerick

1810-1816 – Townland: **Bruff**, Parish: Bruff, **Union: Kilmallock**, Barony: Coshma, County: Limerick

1820 – Townland: **Elton**, Parish: Knockainy, **Union: Kilmallock**, **Barony: Smallcounty**, County: Limerick

Here are the most probable entries in order (where Patrick Mulcahy is listed as Tenant) and the only entries where the Union is Kilmallock, which applies to all three of his previous residences:

1. Patrick Mulcahy, Bruff – Landlord: Thomas Roche, Year: 1851; Place Name: Crawford's Lane, Townland: Bruff, Parish: Bruff, **Union: Kilmallock**, Barony: Coshma, County: Limerick
 - a. The children were all baptised in Bruff, while the family lived in Ballyvolane. They then moved to Elton, which is farther from Bruff. Either the family moved back to the Bruff area after Elton, or this is a different Patrick Mulcahy. This is a *probable* location for Patrick Mulcahy, if he is still living in 1851.
 - b. It is possible the family wanted to be more in a larger town. Bruff is larger than Elton. Crawford's Lane (also Crawford's Street on maps) was in the heart of Bruff. For an aging parent like Patrick, this might have been a place he lived when his children had all moved out.
2. Patrick Mulcahy, Ballinlough – Landlord: Earl of Sandwich, Year: 1851; Townland: Ballinlough, Parish: Ballinlough, **Union: Kilmallock**, **Barony: Smallcounty**, County: Limerick.
 - a. Ballinlough is about 12 kms NE of Elton and 11 kms NE of Ballyvolane
 - b. The Union and Barony match those of Elton, and the proximity of just a few kilometers makes it *probable* as a match for Patrick Mulcahy, who would be about age 63-65 at this time.
 - c. Ballinlough is shown on the previous map as Ballinloghy – north of Hospital and Ballynamona, at top edge of map. The family would not have needed to travel very far to move.

These are name matches for wife Ellen Mulcahy. Showing a first scenario of the family all renting from the Earl of Sandwich on two different Lots of land. The second scenario might be if Patrick has passed and his wife Ellen Bridget was widowed. She could be living with her oldest daughter, Mary, as there are two occurrences where there are an Ellen Mulcahy with a Mary.

1. Ellen Mulcahy, Ballinlough – Landlord: Earl of Sandwich, Year: 1851; Townland: Ballinlough, Parish: Ballinlough, **Union: Kilmallock**, **Barony: Smallcounty**, County: Limerick.
 - a. She is shown with a Mary Conroy on Lots 20. Mary is listed as the tenant of Ellen Mulcahy, and Ellen is the tenant of the Earl of Sandwich. **Find out a marriage record for Mary Mulcahy and see if she married a _____ Conroy and if so, this could be a match.**
 - b. Patrick Mulcahy is also shown on this same page, also renting from the Earl of Sandwich (landlord), on Lot 29 with John Dooley. Patrick is listed as the landlord of John Dooley.
2. Ellen Mulcahy, Kilcullane – Landlord: The O'Grady, Year: 1851; Townland: Herbertstown (O'Grady), Parish: Kilcullane, **Union: Kilmallock**, **Barony: Smallcounty**, County: Limerick
 - a. She is shown with a Mary Mulcahy (unknown if this is her daughter) on Lots 18 and 19 as tenants, with Land, House, and Garden. There is no mention of Patrick Mulcahy or any other Mulcahy's on this evaluation.

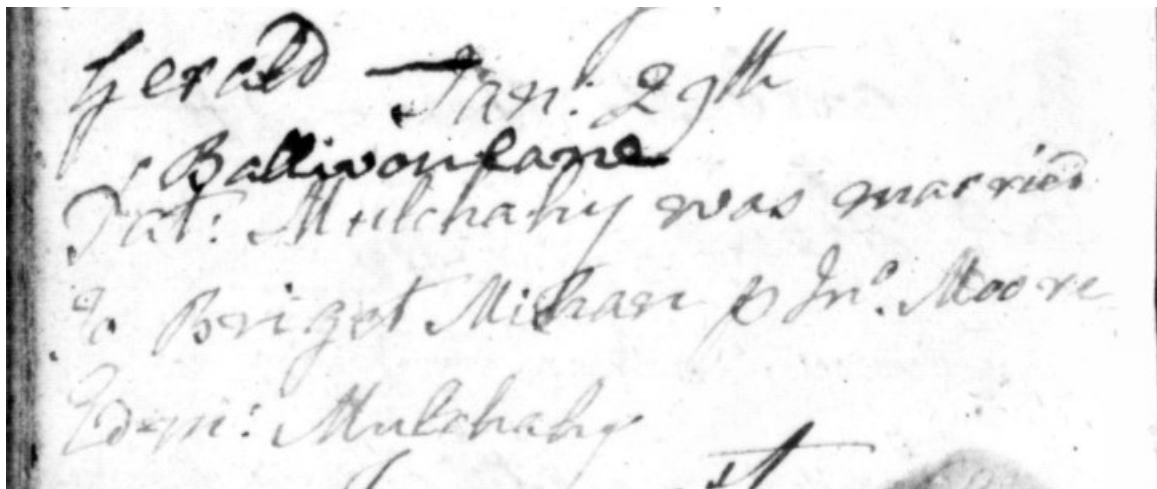

Patrick Mulcahy and Bridget Meehan were married 29 Jan 1806 in Bruff, Limerick, Ireland. Their address is Ballivoulane, which corresponds to Ballyvolane, Banogue, Co. Limerick, Ireland – just southeast of Bruff. This is not to be confused with the other Patrick Mulcahy who married Bridget Haneen in 1812 in Bruff and had a son named Dermot. That family lived in Kilfannane and it is an unknown relation to the Ballyvolane Patrick Mulcahy (your branch).

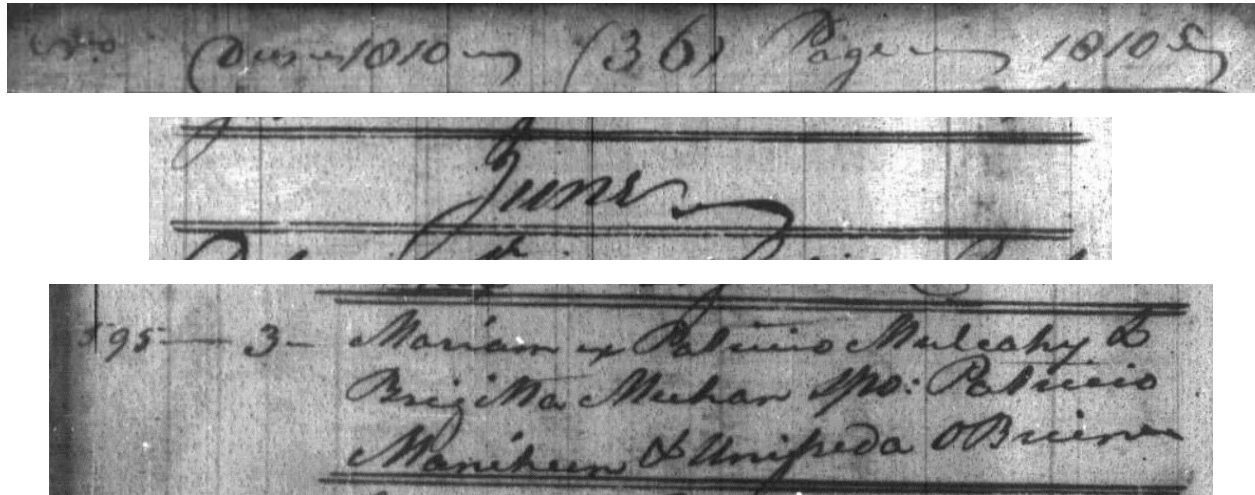

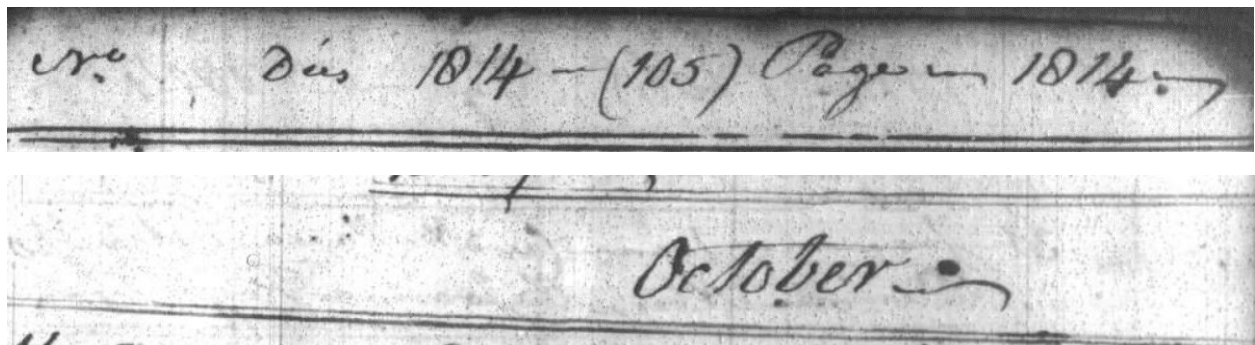

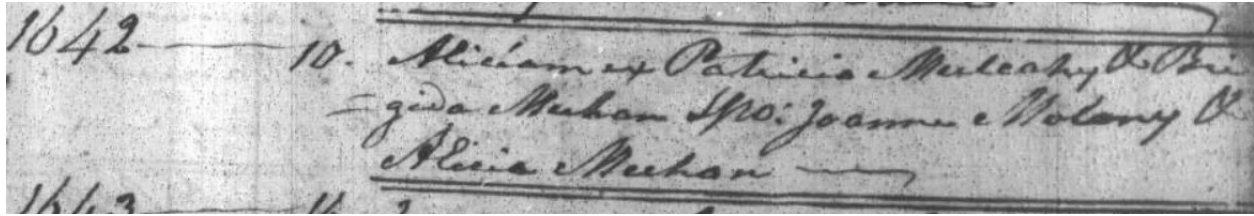

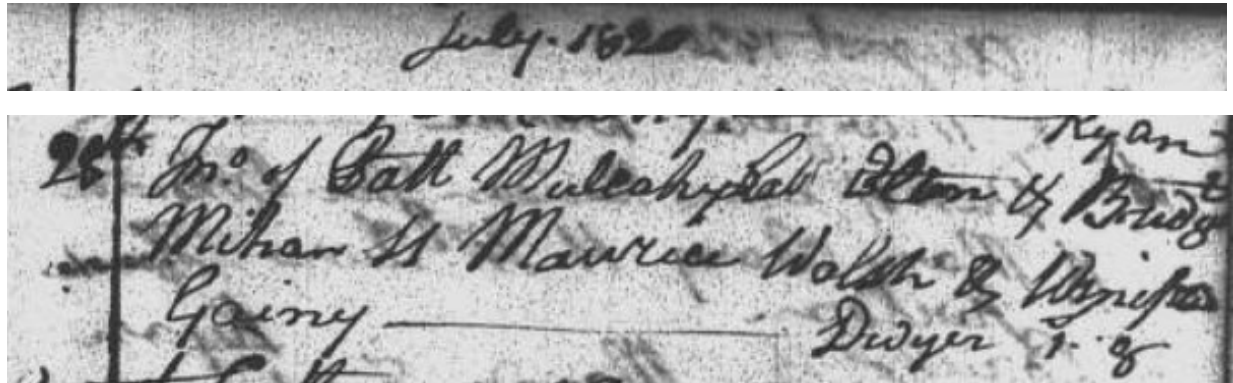

Griffith's Valuation

In 1851, a census was taken for landowners and tenants called Griffith's Valuation. The name Patrick Mulcahy is possible for more than one generation. This could refer to his son or even a different Patrick.
